#### Abstract Details

**Title** – Short yet descriptive. Title block should be at the top of the page, followed by the author(s) information.

**Content** – 300 word maximum. Include statement of problems or thesis; methods of investigation, design or construction; significant results of findings; and conclusion.

**Format** – Use 12 point font size; Times New Roman font style; 1 inch margins; save as Microsoft Word 2003 document (preferred) or as WordPerfect document.

**Session** – Indicate Topic Session for which the paper is most suitable.

**Submittal** – Submit by no later than April 1, 2009. Paper acceptance by April 30, 2009. Submit the final paper and PowerPoint presentation on or before August 1, 2009.

Please center the author(s) information immediately below the title at the top of the paper. Author(s) information must include: full name, organization affiliation, office address, email address and phone number.
